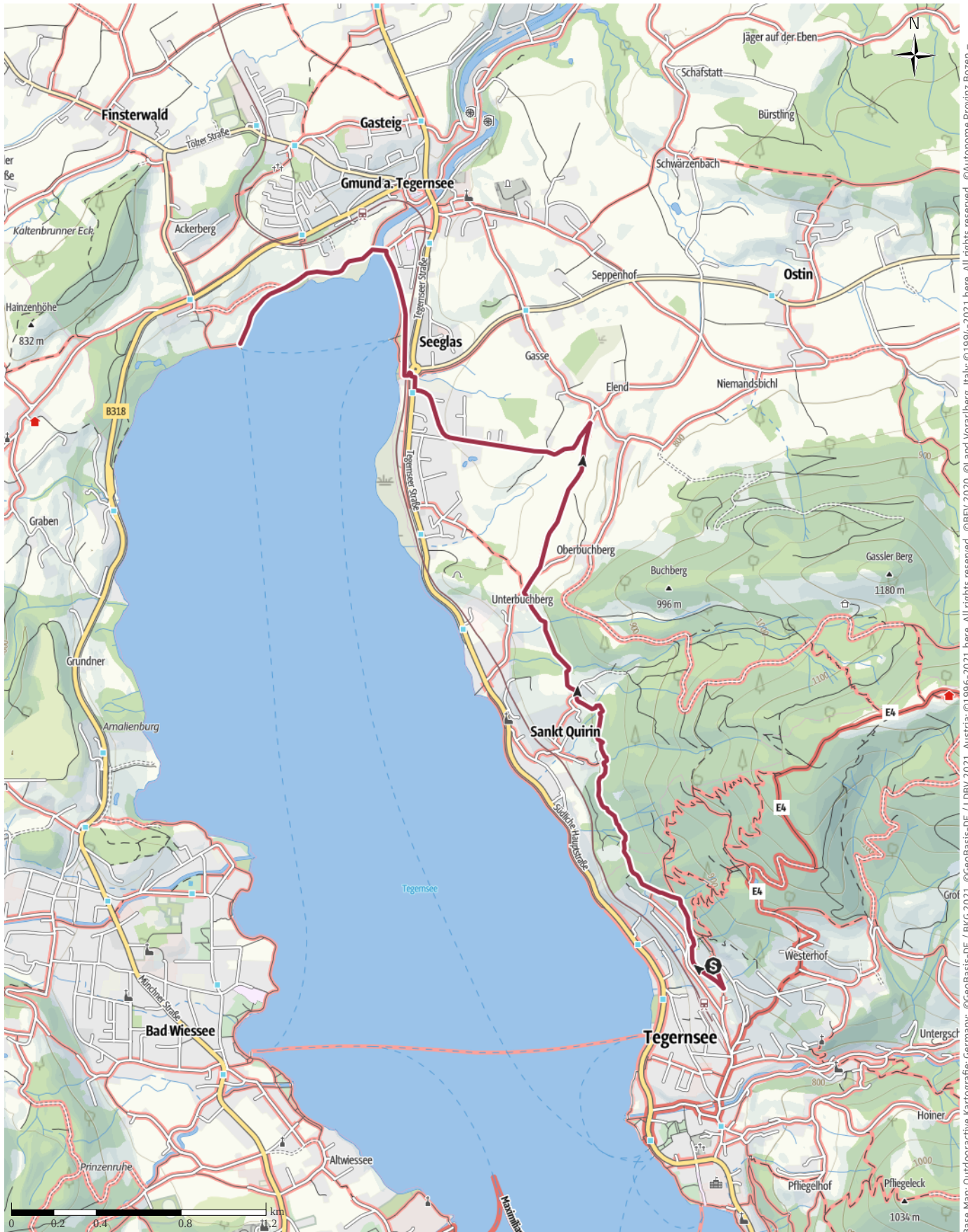

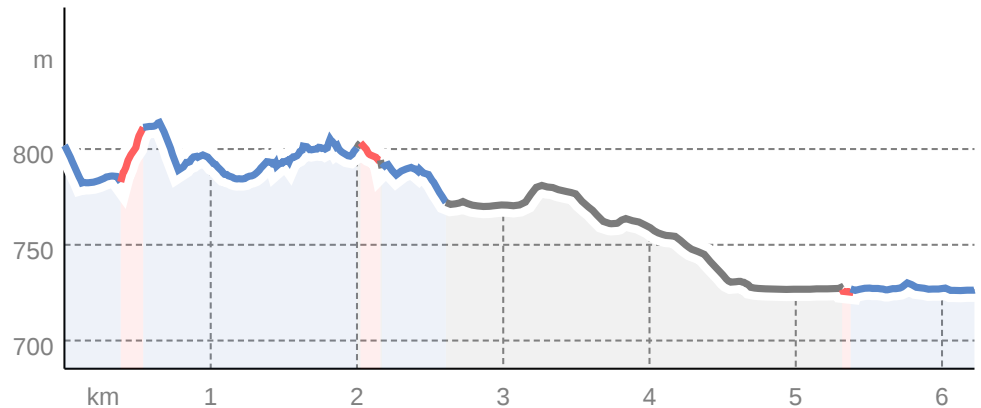

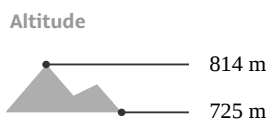

For those looking to experience Lake Tegernsee from a

different perspective, the Tegernsee Panorama Trail offers the perfect combination of nature, exercise and panoramic views. This scenic hike connects DAS TEGERNSEE with the northern shore of the lake, following varied trails above the water through forests, meadows and small hamlets. Along the way, impressive views of Lake Tegernsee and the surrounding mountain landscape open up time and again.

Roadbook

The hike begins directly at DAS TEGERNSEE. After just a few minutes, the route reaches the famous Tegernsee Panorama Trail above the lake. Away from the lakeside promenade, the trail follows quiet paths through mixed forests and sunny meadows, passing traditional

Bavarian farmhouses along the way.

Beautiful viewpoints open up time and again along the route. Your gaze stretches across the shimmering waters of Lake Tegernsee, the surrounding villages and the distinctive peaks of the Mangfall Mountains. The changing perspectives are what make this hike particularly appealing.

The Panorama Trail follows gentle ups and downs through the villages and small hamlets above the lake. Shady woodland sections alternate with open meadows, revealing new views of the landscape at every turn.

As you continue north, the landscape gradually opens up. Eventually, you reach Gmund am Tegernsee, where the lake flows into the Mangfall River and the panorama takes on a new character. The cosy cafés and restaurants in the village centre are perfect for a relaxing break.

Return: Along the lakeshore

If you would like to end the day with a leisurely walk, follow the lakeside path back towards Tegernsee. The route runs directly along the water, offering beautiful views of the lake and mountains.

Return: By boat across Lake Tegernsee

Alternatively, you can take a boat operated by Tegernsee-Schiffahrt from Gmund or one of the nearby piers. From the water, you will experience an entirely new perspective of the villages around the lake and the surrounding mountains. Depending on your preference, you can continue to Tegernsee or even on to Rottach-Egern, bringing your hiking experience to a relaxed close.
