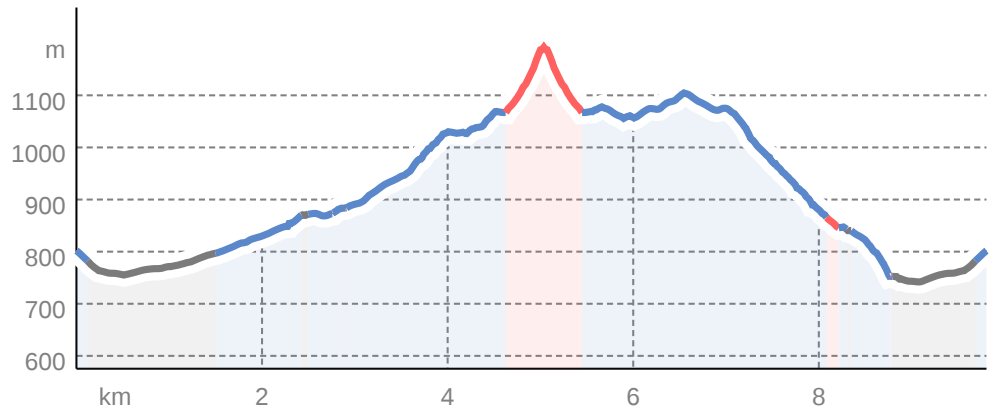

Few hiking destinations combine history, nature and panoramic views as impressively as the Riederstein Chapel. Perched high above Lake Tegernsee on a distinctive rocky outcrop, the small chapel offers unparalleled views across the lake and the surrounding mountains. Combined with the traditional Berggasthof Galaun, this varied circular hike is the perfect way to spend half a day in the mountains.

Author's recommendation

Interesting Facts about Riederstein Chapel

The small chapel was built in the 19th century on the distinctive Riederstein rock and is now one of the best-known landmarks of the Tegernsee Valley. Thanks to its spectacular location, it is also one of the region's most photographed viewpoints.

Safety information

- The hike mainly follows well-marked forest trails and forest roads. The final section to Riederstein

Chapel, however, involves a steeper ascent of around 500 steps.

- In wet, snowy or icy conditions, the steps and narrower forest paths can become slippery. Check the current weather and trail conditions before setting out.
- Sturdy hiking shoes with a good-grip sole are recommended.
- Please stay on the designated hiking trails and be considerate of other hikers and the natural environment.

Equipment

- Ankle-high hiking or sturdy outdoor shoes with a good-grip sole
- Weather-appropriate layered clothing
- Lightweight rain jacket – mountain weather can change quickly
- Sufficient drinking water
- Sun protection (sunscreen, sunglasses and a hat)
- Hiking poles optional – particularly useful for the descent
- Cash for the alpine huts
- Camera or binoculars for the panoramic views from Riederstein
- A fully charged mobile phone for emergencies

Roadbook

The hike begins directly at DAS TEGERNSEE and initially leads through the idyllic Alpbach Valley. Following pleasant forest trails and forest roads, you will walk uphill alongside the gently flowing Alpbach stream. The steady ascent makes this first section particularly

enjoyable, with beautiful views of the peaceful woodland landscape along the way.

After around one and a half hours, you will reach the traditional Berggasthof Galaun. Its sunny terrace is the perfect place for a first break and already offers magnificent views across Lake Tegernsee and the surrounding mountains.

From Galaun, the trail continues uphill towards Riederstein Chapel. The final section consists of around 500 steps leading up to the distinctive rocky outcrop. Once at the top, one of the most beautiful viewpoints in the Tegernsee Valley awaits. The view stretches across Lake Tegernsee and the Mangfall Mountains and, on clear days, far into the Bavarian Alps.

After taking time to enjoy the panorama, the return journey begins via Pfliegeleck. The trail follows scenic forest paths, offering impressive views of the lake along the way. Once you reach Pfliegeleck, it is worth taking a short break to enjoy the panorama once more.

From there, the route descends along well-maintained hiking trails back towards Tegernsee. Following quiet paths, you will eventually return to DAS TEGERNSEE.
