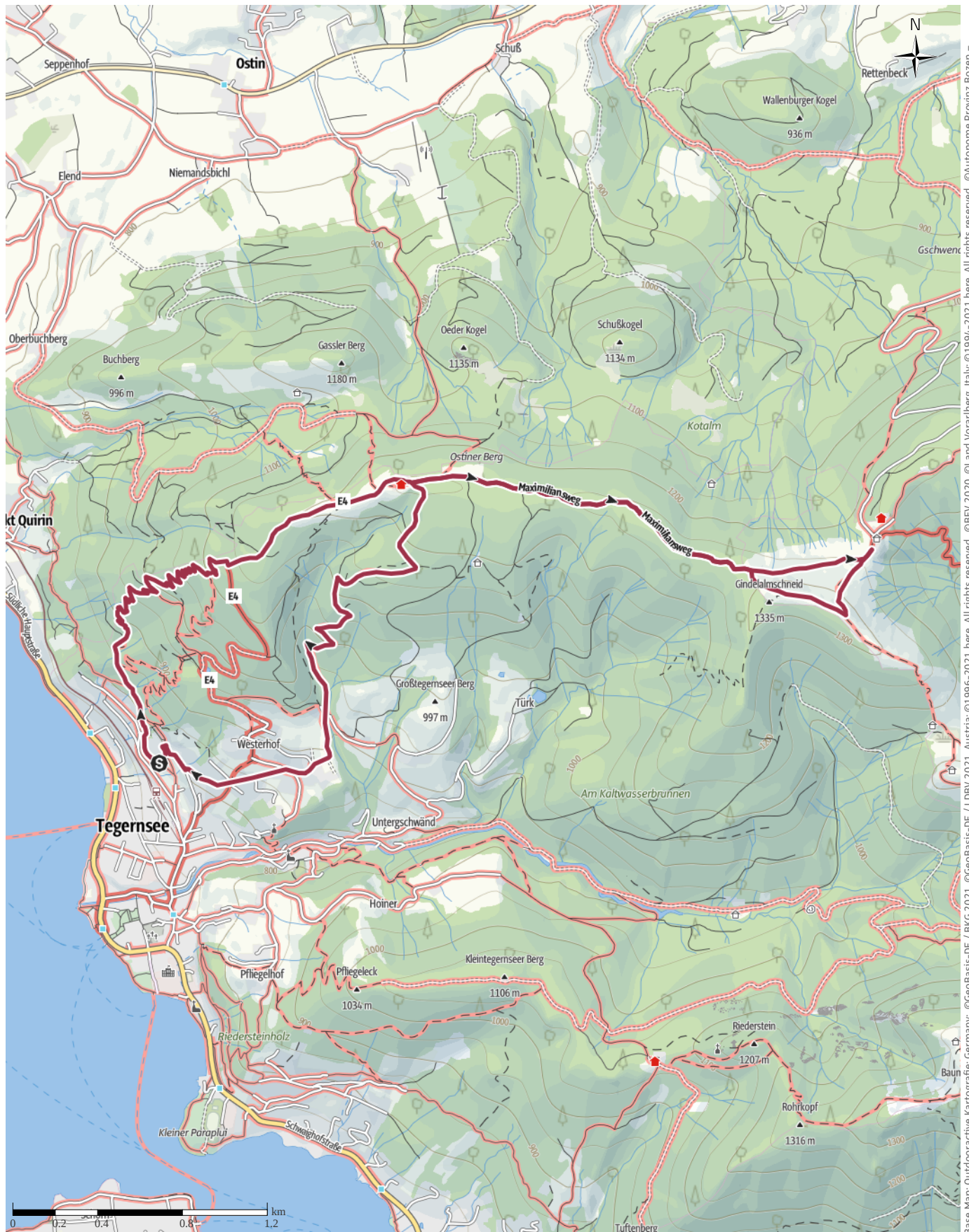

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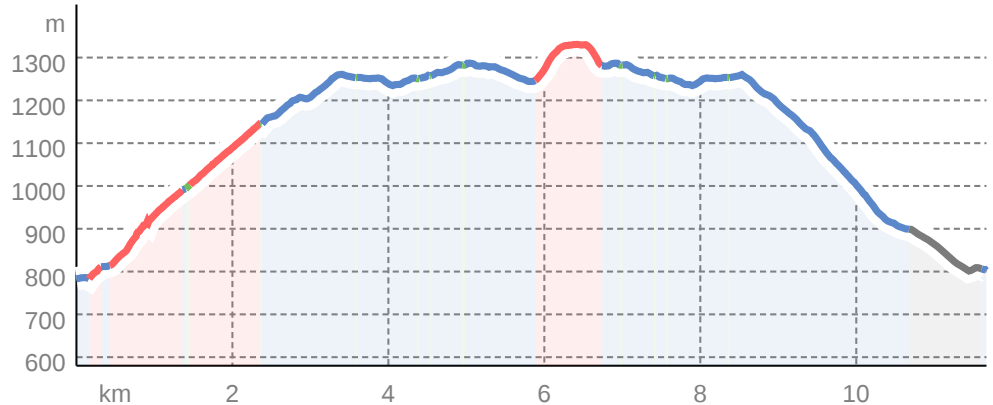

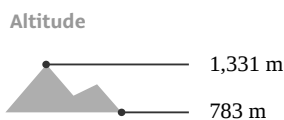

This varied hike combines the popular Neureuth with the scenic Gindelalmschneid. Open alpine meadows, traditional mountain huts and impressive views of Lake Tegernsee, Lake Schliersee and the surrounding peaks make this one of the most beautiful hiking experiences starting directly from the hotel.

Safety information

- The hike mainly follows well-marked trails and forest roads. However, some sections of the ascent to Neureuth lead along narrower forest paths, which can become slippery when wet.
- Wear sturdy hiking shoes with good grip and check the current weather conditions before setting out.
- During the summer months, you may encounter grazing livestock on the alpine meadows. Please close all pasture gates, keep a safe distance from the animals and stay on the designated trails.
- The route passes through alpine terrain. Allow

sufficient time for the hike and make sure to carry enough drinking water.

Equipment

- Ankle-high hiking boots with a good-grip sole
- Weather-appropriate clothing in layers Rain jacket – mountain weather can change quickly
- Sufficient drinking water and a small snack
- Sun protection (sunscreen, sunglasses and a hat)
- Hiking poles are particularly recommended for the longer descent
- A fully charged mobile phone for emergencies
- Cash for the alpine huts

Roadbook

Starting directly from DAS TEGERNSEE, the route initially follows the Tegernsee Panorama Trail northwards. Within the first few metres, you are rewarded with beautiful views of Lake Tegernsee before reaching the hiking trail towards Neureuth after just a few minutes.

For the ascent, the route follows the narrower forest trail on the western side of the mountain. The path winds its way uphill through the mountain forest in numerous switchbacks, repeatedly revealing impressive views of Lake Tegernsee and the surrounding peaks of the Mangfall Mountains.

After around one and a half hours, you will reach Neureuth. If you wish, this is the perfect place for a first break or a short detour to the picturesque Neureuth Chapel.

From Neureuth, the trail continues along a scenic ridge path towards the Gindelalm. The route leads through open alpine meadows and light forest sections, offering magnificent panoramic views of the Bavarian Prealps along the way. After approximately another hour, you will reach the three traditional huts of

Gindelalm, which are ideal for a relaxing stop and refreshments.

For the return journey, we recommend following the same route back towards Neureuth and then taking the wide forest road on the eastern side. The well-maintained path leads through shady forests back down into the valley. Once you reach the outskirts of Tegernsee, follow Neureuthstraße back to DAS TEGERNSEE.
