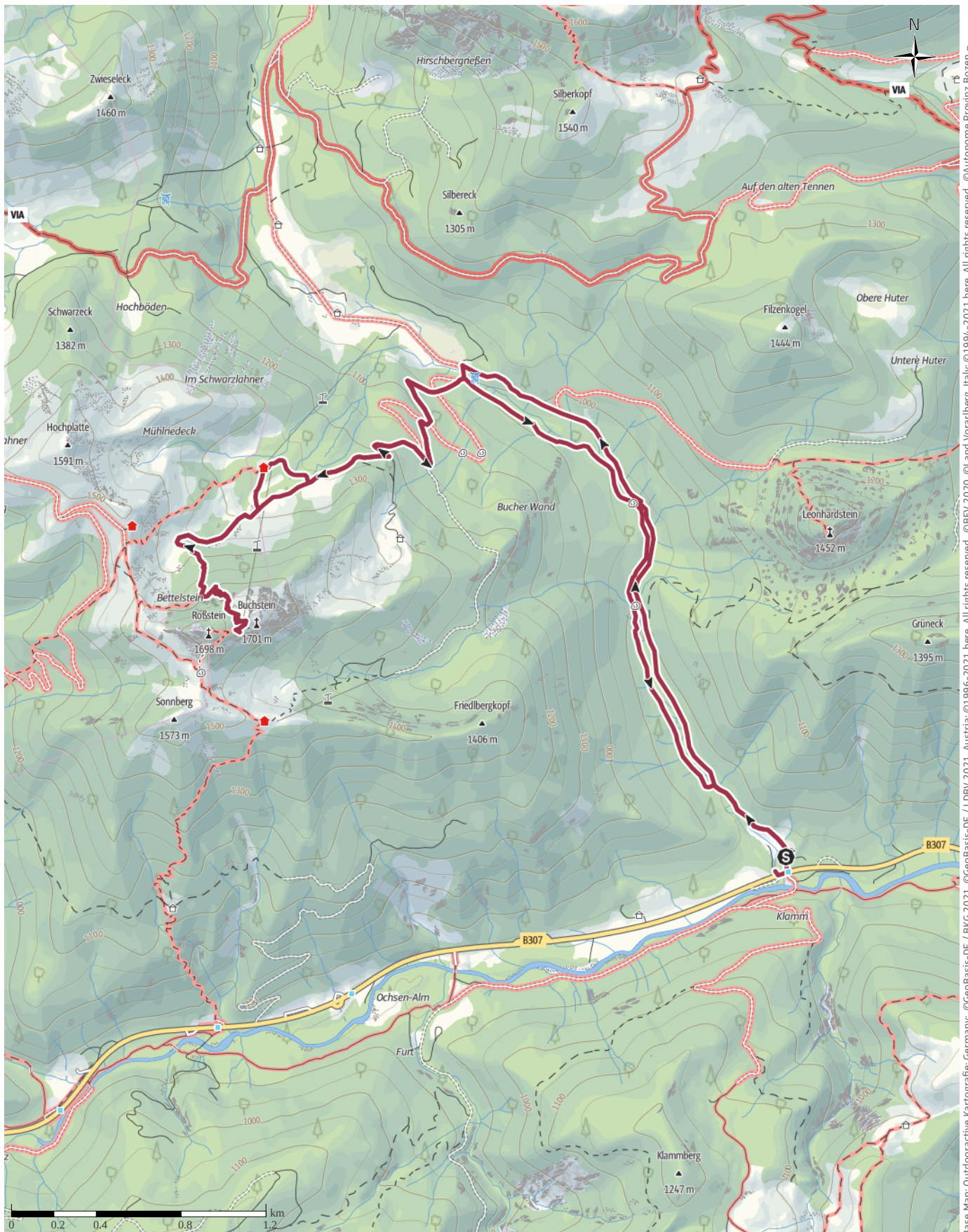

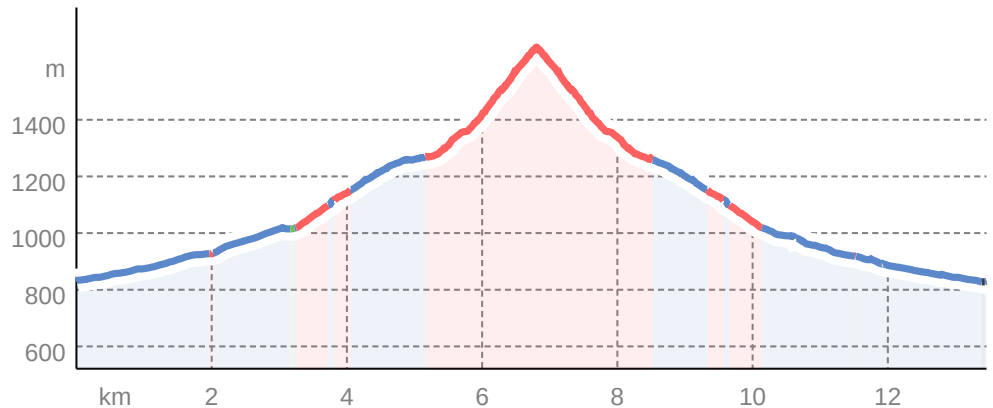

Schwarzenbach into the impressive mountain landscape around Buchstein and Roßstein. Passing the Schwarzenbach waterfall and following increasingly alpine mountain trails, the route climbs towards the spectacularly situated Tegernseer Hütte. The challenging ascent is rewarded with impressive views and an authentic alpine experience. This tour is particularly suitable for experienced hikers with good fitness, sure-footedness and a good head for heights.

Safety information

- Challenging mountain hike with approximately 826 metres of elevation gain.
- Good fitness, sure-footedness and a good head for heights are required.
- The upper sections include some steep and narrow mountain trails.
- In wet conditions, rocks, roots and trails can become slippery.
- The tour should not be undertaken in bad weather

This varied mountain hike leads from Kreuth along the

or during thunderstorms.

- Check the current weather and trail conditions before setting out.
- Allow sufficient time for both the ascent and descent.

Equipment

- Sturdy, ankle-high hiking boots with a good-grip sole
- Weather-appropriate mountain clothing
- Sufficient drinking water and provisions
- Rain and wind protection
- Sun protection and sunglasses
- A small first-aid kit
- Hiking poles can be particularly helpful on the descent
- Cash for the alpine huts

Roadbook

The hike begins in Kreuth and initially follows well-maintained paths towards Schwarzentennalm. After the first few metres, you can either continue along the forest road or switch to the hiking trail following the Schwarzenbach. We particularly recommend the hiking trail, which climbs gently through the forest, passing small streams and crossing several bridges and footbridges.

A highlight of this section is the Schwarzenbach waterfall. A short detour takes you to the clearly audible and visible waterfall – a lovely spot for a brief break before continuing the ascent.

The trail then continues alongside the Schwarzenbach. Gradually, the ascent becomes steeper and the landscape increasingly alpine. Following varied forest trails and forest roads, you continue towards

Buchsteinhütte. If you wish, you can make a detour to Schwarzentennalm beforehand.

As you gain elevation, the forest becomes more open and the first views of the surrounding peaks and Tegernseer Hütte appear. The route now continues uphill across alpine meadows and increasingly challenging mountain trails. Several steeper sections, root-covered paths and rocky passages require sure-footedness and sturdy hiking boots.

Buchsteinhütte is an ideal place for a first refreshment stop before tackling the most demanding section of the tour. From here, the trail continues along the foothills of Buchstein. The terrain becomes increasingly rocky, with several higher steps and rock sections to negotiate. A series of switchbacks then leads uphill towards the open area below Tegernseer Hütte.

Shortly before reaching the destination, the trail becomes steeper once more. Above the hut, a short secured section with a cable leads onto a small ridge. From here, an impressive panorama of the surrounding mountains opens up – on clear days, the view stretches far across the Bavarian Alps.

After an extended break at the summit and hut, the descent begins along the designated route back to Kreuth.
